What's Happening in the Foundation Office

It has been another exciting and eventful few months in the Foundation Office as we disburse the Spring semester scholarships and begin to work with our donors for contributions for the 2024-25 academic year. The Donor Recognition Wall was a major undertaking for the Foundation this past fall and looks wonderful in the Commons area on the Virginia campus.

We are very excited to begin a new collaborative effort with all of the Minnesota North College campuses to formulate one scholarship portal for all students / potential students attending the Minnesota North College. This new venture includes the Hibbing, Itasca, Mesabi Range, Rainy River and Vermilion Foundations. The scholarship portal will provide opportunities for students to make one application to all of the scholarships they qualify for at the campus they are attending, as well as any additional scholarships provided through the Minnesota North College administrative offices.

The Foundation Office has been working with the Athletic Department to develop etched plexiglass panels to honor those inducted into the Mesabi Range Athletic Hall of Fame. Chris Vito (Interim Athletic Director) has been working with Randy Washenesky (Welding Instructor – Eveleth Campus) and his students to prepare the panels and have them installed by March, 2024. In addition, we plan on having a list of Mesabi Range NJCAA All-Americans and Minnesota College Athletic Conference Hall of Fame Inductees on display in the gymnasium area on the Virginia campus.

Campus Update

Spring semester 2024 started off smoothly for Minnesota North College with enrollment numbers staying stable compared to last year. Enrollment is up for the first time since 2011 and applications for new students for the 24-25 academic year are up by 23%. Over winter break, staff returned over 300 phone calls to prospective students who have shown interest in Minnesota North College. A few highlights of the amazing things that faculty and staff are planning this spring are:

On February 29, from 9 am—2pm, the Enrollment/Recruiting department will hold a Women in the Workforce event highlighting women in the trades, to students in grades 10-12, on the Eveleth campus. The Spring Open House, on both Virginia and Eveleth campuses, will be held on Thursday, March 14 from 3pm-6pm. Eveleth will host their annual Skills and Knowledge Fair, which allows high school students to engage in hands-on projects within the departments on campus. These projects will be highlighted at the Open House that same evening.



• On March 12, the Welding Department at Eveleth will co-host the annual "Behind the Mask" competition with the Arrowhead Section of the American Welding Society (AWS). Welders from the region, area businesses, and other sister colleges are invited to enter different competition categories. At the end, scholarships and prizes are awarded for those that placed within the focus areas of competition. Many employees also attend to see how students perform- - a great sneak peak at spring's hiring pool!

Thanks to grant funding you will start to see some new advertising as Minnesota

North College Billboards begin to pop up along the Hwy 169 and Hwy 53 corridors. Watch for one in Canyon as you Head North!

• The Mesabi Range Equity and Diversity team, led by Antavius Thomas, hosted a successful Martin Luther King March and Rally on Monday, January 15. The event included a one-mile walk, a great lineup of powerful speakers, a bouncy house and face painting. Several Eveleth campus programs attended the Bois Forte program fair on January 26, showcasing the great opportunities Minnesota North College programs have to offer.



- Minnesota North College website 2.0 is coming..... Early this summer we will see a new and improved Minnesota North College website. This will include updated graphics, a more streamlined appearance, and increased speed.
- Minnesota North College is in the midst of submitting accreditation documents for the Higher Learning Commission to review prior to their visit on April 8 and 9. This is a regular 4-year cycle review in line with the legacy college past reviews. We look forward to visiting with the HLC team and showing them all of the great strategies we have implemented to reach our goals in promoting student success.
- MaryKay Riendeau and the Addiction Studies department will host a Multi-Cultural Addiction event, "A Disease that Doesn't Discriminate," along with Narcan training on the Virginia campus on April 25. Four amazing speakers will talk about how addiction affected their lives. It will be attended by over 200 Minnesota North faculty and staff, Addiction Studies program students, and area treatment center and human services behavioral health employees. Since 2019, MaryKay has successfully obtained over \$2,838,000 in grants from Blue Cross Blue Shield, St. Louis County, and The Department of Human Services to support students in the Addiction Studies and Human Services Program.

Donor Profiles Dan and Yvonne Webb

Dan and Yvonne are one of the four major donors to contribute over \$250,000 to the Mesabi Range Foundation. Dan is a graduate from Hibbing High School after attending Gilbert High School until grade 10. Dan received his college degree from the Michigan Technological University. Yvonne went to work immediately after her high school graduation in a suburb of Cleveland, Ohio.

In 2015 they established the Dan and Yvonne Webb Scholarship at the Mesabi Range Foundation – a scholarship given to Engineering students who are in their junior or senior year attending the Mankato State University Iron Range Engineering program at the Mesabi Range campus. As a former Iron Range resident, Dan wanted to give back to the students in our area who share his passion for Engineering.

Dan and Yvonne are granting \$24,000 in scholarship funding annually. Women from Northeastern Minnesota are given preference for this award, and scholarships are given to first semester students in the "Bell Academy" as part of the I.R.E. program. In addition to the scholarships given in their name at Mesabi Range, Dan and Yvonne have been active in providing funding for engineering students at Itasca Community College and Michigan Tech.

Dan and Yvonne currently reside in Santa Ana, California, and are an important part of the Iron Range Engineering Program at Mesabi Range. The Mesabi Range Foundation Board of Directors and Mesabi Range faculty and staff are extremely grateful for the Webb's charitable contributions and their support of the students attending the Mesabi Range campuses.

Peter and Colette Johnson

Peter and Colette Johnson are one of the major donors to the Mesabi Range Foundation, contributing over \$250,000 to the Foundation since 2002. Colette is a graduate from Mesabi State Junior College, while Peter received his degree from the Michigan Technological University. The Johnson family's initial scholarship donation was made in honor of their children. They gave their children an opportunity to donate to any charity of their choice, and they selected the Mesabi Range Foundation.

In 2003, Peter and Colette created a scholarship in memory of her parents – Bud and Lillian Kishel. Her parents were strong proponents of education, with the expectation that their children would go to the local junior college after graduating from high school. Colette's mother, Lillian, attended Eveleth Junior College, while Colette and her brothers attended Virginia Junior College.

The C.E. "Bud" and Lillian Kishel Scholarship was given to a returning sophomore student demonstrating dedication and aptitude in their chosen field. The initial scholarship was given to a student attending Mesabi Range – Eveleth campus, and in ensuing years two scholarships were awarded – one scholarship to a student attending the Virginia campus, and one scholarship to a student enrolled at the Eveleth campus.

Peter and Colette continued their charitable giving to the Foundation each year, and in 2007 made an additional \$50,000 contribution to create the Johnson Family Scholarship – a scholarship given to a student majoring in engineering, math or science fields. Because of their kindness, generosity and subsequent donations, this \$5,000 scholarship continues to be awarded.

Sadly, Peter passed away on September 26, 2023, at the age of 87. He was a devoted husband and father, a respected local entrepreneur and business owner, and an avid outdoorsman. He had a dynamic personality and a keen sense of humor. Colette resides on Lake Vermilion, Tower, MN. The Mesabi Range Foundation Board of Directors and Mesabi Range faculty and staff are extremely grateful for the Johnson family's charitable contributions and their support of the students attending the Mesabi Range campuses.

New Range Copper Nickel Grant

The Mesabi Range Foundation was recently awarded a \$5,000 grant from NewRange Copper Nickel to support the Foundation's effort to expand the promotion of scholarship opportunities, provide continued program support for the Foundation Office, and help support creative initiatives for the students attending the Mesabi Range campuses.

Mesabi Range recruited some great local talent this season in Nakaiyah Nimene from Floodwood, Madeline Kallberg from Ely and Katie Peck from Grand Marais. Nakaiyah is currently the leading scorer at 11.2 points per game and 2.7 steals per game. Deetra Davis is a close second on the team averaging 11.0 points per game. She is Mesabi's team leader in rebounds, averaging 12.3 rebounds per game; and, Elizabeth Hey is Mesabi's assist machine, averaging 3.2 assists per game.


This season, Mesabi Range has a great group of sophomore leadership with five returners from last year:

Even though Mesabi Range has had their ups and downs this year and have been dealt with injury after injury, they keep competing in every game. Currently, they sit fourth in their conference and hold the last playoff spot as of January 28. The second half of the season starts in February and they are looking to go on a playoff run. All five sophomores were All-Academic last year as freshmen and all five sophomores will also be graduating this spring. "That is something to be proud of and is better than any win or loss," claims Head Coach Brad Matuszak.


